About Bawal

Bawal is a town in the district of Rewari, situated near the Delhi-Jaipur National Highway. This town was a part of Jhajjar princely state prior to the mutiny of 1857. Later, Bawal fell into the hands of Nabha chief Hira Singh, and he built a fort here in 1875. The fort is built of slate and stone masonry. It was one of the three districts of erstwhile Nabha State. Nabha State was one of the many princely states under the British Raj administration. Although this princely state was based in Punjab, its ancestral roots were from Jaisalmer, Rajasthan. One of the highlights of this princely state was its unflinching loyalty to the British Raj. This was proven beyond doubt when it chose to remain loyal to the British even during the 1857 mutiny. In return for this deep loyalty, Nabha State was monetarily rewarded by the British, and their rulers were always treated with immense respect by British officials.

About the College

This college was set up by the Bawal Janta Educational and Cultural Board on July 1, 1974. It was converted into Govt. College Bawal after the Govt. of Haryana took it over on January 14, 1980. This is the oldest government college in the district of Rewari. This college is spread over 9.5 acres of land. It has well-equipped laboratories, library, reading room and class rooms constructed in Indian architectural style. The college provides all the required facilities for sports and recreation to ensure the holistic development of students. The college is engaged in providing co-education around Bawal Chorasi and it has Arts faculty with English, Hindi, Sanskrit, History, Political Science, Mathematics, Economics and Geography as subjects, as well as Commerce and Non-Medical faculty. Students from this college have not only earned names and fame in education; they have also won medals in university and state-level sports events. Students also take active part in programmes organized by National Service Scheme (NSS).
